1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.167 dated 01.07.2020 under Sections 307/323/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division 'B', District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Vide order dated 24.04.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.04.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Roop Lal has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

4. In view of the above, interim order dated 24.04.2023 is

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made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under
Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
