The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.4 to stop throwing the garbage adjacent to the residence of the petitioner and to consider representation dated 03.06.2020 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner to respondent Nos. 2 to 4.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 contends that he would have no objection in case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take a decision on the representation submitted by the petitioner (Annexure P-2) along with present writ petition.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, position was the same even on the last date of hearing.

Taking into consideration, the statement made by counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4, present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4 to consider the representation Annexed along with instant petition as Annexure P-2 to take an appropriate action thereupon after being an opportunity hearing of the petitioner. The necessary reason might be concluded within a period of 3 months.

The present writ petition is disposed of.
