At the very outset, in light of the dicta in *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, (2008) 2 SCC 409* and *M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, (2020) 16 SCC 728*, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to approach the Magistrate concerned under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. regarding his prayer for registration of FIR on the basis of representation/complaint dated 22.02.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-3). He further prays that with regard to his other plea seeking protection of life and liberty, petitioner be permitted to move a fresh representation to the concerned quarters.

Learned State counsel submits that in the present petition no specific instance of threat has been mentioned by the petitioner and in

case any such representation is received, the same would be disposed of in accordance with law.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with the observation that petitioner is at liberty to take recourse to the statutory remedy noticed above and in case any representation regarding threat to life and liberty is made to respondent No.2, the same be dealt with in accordance with law.
