1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners as they apprehend threat at the hands of respondents No.3 to 12. It was further prayed that appropriate directions may be issued to respondents No.1 and 2, not to falsely involve the petitioners in a false case.

2. Pursuant to the notice, a short reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, which is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that a complaint/representation was received from Arjinder Singh, petitioner No.1, which was marked to SHO, Police Station for enquiry and report and as per the report, no truth was found in the complaint filed by petitioner No.1 and the said representation was ordered to

be filed. Learned State counsel further submits that the Panchayat Department has got an FIR No.53 dated 17.06.2018 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Ranger Nangal registered against petitioner No.1 and others and there is no threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. Learned State counsel further submits that the investigation in the above-said case FIR No.53 dated 17.06.2018 shall be conducted fairly and impartially. Learned counsel further contends that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners with regard to threat to their lives and liberty, the same shall be looked into and action shall be taken as per law.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
