1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition.
2. Permission granted.
3. Consequently, the extant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the demarcation reports, if any, which are placed on record, are permitted to be relied upon by the *Sarpanch* of the Gram Panchayat concerned, and, thereupon the Gram Panchayat, forthwith instituting a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) 1961, before the Collector concerned.
4. On such a petition being forthwith instituted, the same shall be decided in accordance with law but after giving an opportunity of hearing to all affected persons. The said eviction petition is also directed to be decided within a period four months of its preferment.
5. Since the main case itself has been decided, all the pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
