1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release the complete retiral/pensionary benefits i.e. gratuity, dearness allowance, GPF/PF, leave encashment, medical allowance etc. and arrears of increment alongwith interest. He submitted that representations have been given to the concerned authorities vide Annexure P-2 and P-3 respectively, but the same have not been considered or decided as yet.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines the prayer of the present petition to decide the representations Annexure P-2 and P-3.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr. Vikram Preet Arora, Advocate who is present in Court has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No. 3-Executive Officer,

Nagar Council, Gidderbaha and have stated that they have no objection in case both the representations Annexure P-2 and P-3 made by the petitioner are considered and decided by the competent authority, i.e. the Nagar Council in accordance with law.

5. In view of the aforesaid position, this Court deems it fit and proper to dispose of the present petition without calling for reply from the Nagar Council or any other authority since the prayer is made only for deciding of both the representations. Therefore, without observing anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to consider and decide both the representations Annexure P-2 and P-3 strictly in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from today.

6. The present petition stands disposed of.
