The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to perform the statutory duty cast upon it in terms of Section 17(2)(xii) read with Section 89(4) of the Registration Act 1908 and to enter mutation qua the property bearing Plot No.TP-4, Phase-1, Sector 38, Rai Sonepat in favour of the petitioners to the extent of their respective shares as per the certificate of sale dated 29.11.2022 Annexure P-4.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would submit that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case the representation dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-12) ventilating their grievance, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 07.04.2023 (Annexure P-12) of the petitioners within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
