The petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that till date despite the needful having been done at the end of the petitioner, the physical possession of the plot, so allotted, has not been handed over to the petitioner. The petitioner has been approaching the respondent(s) for the said relief as has been prayed for in the present writ petition and the latest representation which has been submitted is of dated 15.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) and that also has not yielded any result. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula to consider and decide the same within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pravindra S. Chauhan, Sr. Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-HSVP.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition with a direction to the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran (HSVP), Panchkula-respondent No.2 to consider

and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-6), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be also granted to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

Disposed of, accordingly.
