[1]. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for the issuance of directions to respondents to release the petitioner forthwith as petitioner has already undergone the entire sentence as per para 2(b) of the Policy dated 12.04.2002 (Annexure P-2).

[2]. During pendency of the present petition, an order dated 29.11.2023 has been passed by the Addl. Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Jails Department, declining the prayer made by the petitioner.

[3]. Confronted with the aforesaid order dated 29.11.2023, wherein no reasons have been recorded, learned State counsel on instructions from Lakhbir Singh Brar (HJS), Chief Probation Officer from the O/o D.G. Prisons, Haryana, Panchkula submits that the case of the petitioner shall be reconsidered and dealt with by passing a detailed speaking/reasoned order.

[4]. In view of above stand taken by learned State counsel, the order dated 29.11.2023 passed by the Addl. Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Jails Department loses its significance as respondents shall pass a fresh detailed and speaking order.

[5]. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
