Learned counsel for the respondents informed the Court that the Special Leave to appeal (C) No.5440-2023, which was preferred by the respondents-HSVP against the order dated 14.02.2023 passed by this Court, has been dismissed on 24.03.2023. He further states that after dismissal of the said SLP by the Supreme Court, an amount of Rs.20,65,432/- has been paid by the bank to the beneficiaries i.e. the petitioner and further amount of Rs.11,31,870/- including 10% TDS has been paid through RTGS on 11.04.2023.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has not received any specific instructions in this regard.

However, keeping in view the documents which have been placed on

record by the learned counsel for the respondents, we dispose of the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate application in case the amount is not credited to the petitioner.
