TRIBHUVAN DAHIYA J. (ORAL):

This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents for taking action on the complaint dated 19.3.2023 (Annexure P-16) and for filing report under section 173 Cr.P.C. against the private respondents.

Learned State counsel filed reply dated 16.5.2023, which is taken on record. She, on instructions from PSI Vijay, submits that the representation was looked into, and the record with regard to verification of passport was also searched. None of the alleged documents/passport etc. was found to have been made in Haryana. All these documents were generated under the stamp of Punjab Government only. She further submits that none of the accused was found to be staying at the given address in Sector 6, Panchkula. Statement of the owner of the house has also been recorded. He is a retired Army Officer and has been staying there alone.

In view thereof, there is no ground to issue the directions sought by the petitioner. The petition is, accordingly, disposed of granting her liberty to approach the appropriate authorities, if so advised.
