The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR No.121 dated 09.07.2018 under Section 366 of IPC, registered at Police Station Punjab Agricultural University (PAU), District Ludhiana (Annexure P-5) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel submits that in the present matter, cancellation report had been presented on 29.11.2022; and the said cancellation report has been accepted by learned trial Court on 30.11.2022. He further submits that accordingly the present petition has become infructuous.

A perusal of order sheet reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last two dates i.e. 20.05.2022 and 28.10.2022. Even today, no one has put in appearance on his behalf.
