The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.42 dated 27.02.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to following order dated 16.07.2020, passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

“Notice of motion for 26.08.2020.

Mr. Pawan Kumar Sharda, Senior DAG, Punjab, to accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper-book be supplied to him.

Let the complainant be added as respondent No.2 in the case and be notified for the date fixed. Thereafter, both sides are directed to file brief summary of the list of events along with copies of the relevant connected documents before the petition for bail is further taken up for consideration. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;*
- 3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel on instructions states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 16.07.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
