[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for setting aside order, Annexure P/4 dated 15.03.2022 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), Jalalabad (W) whereby the application under Order 7 Rule 11 read with Section 151 CPC filed by the respondents was allowed and the petitioner directed to pay ad valorem court fee on the sale consideration mentioned in the impugned sale deeds on or before 25.04.2022.
