This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondent No.5 Panchayat Secretary, who is violating the rules and regulations of the Panchayat Raj Act, 1994 as well as the Panchayat Raj (Gram Panchayat) Rules, 2012 in Gram Panchayat village Manawan, Block Kot Isha Khan, District Moga.
