This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of impugned complaint bearing No.549 dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) titled as 'Smt. Meetu Gupta Vs. Piyush Infrastructures India Pvt. Ltd. Etc.,' summoning order dated 12.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) and all proceedings arising therefrom as well as order dated 08.02.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Faridabad in Criminal Revision No.15 of 2019 filed by the complainant/respondent against the orders dated 03.12.2018 and 17.12.2018 passed in above said complaint, whereby, the learned Sessions Judge, Faridabad has erred in law while setting aside the above said orders passed by the learned JMFC, Faridabad and learned Trial Court was directed to give opportunity to the respondent to file necessary RC/AD etc for service of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the instant petition has become infructuous as the petitioners have been acquitted by the Court of learned JMFC, Faridabad, vide order dated 17.12.2022.
