This is petitioner's 2nd attempt to get bail during the pendency of criminal case arising from FIR No.104, dated 27.06.2019, registered under Sections 22 & 29 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, later on challan presented under Sections 22, 29, 31, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act (Act 61 of 1985), at Police Station Sadar, District Sangrur.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was allegedly apprehended with 1050 intoxicating tablets Clovidol 100-SR containing the Tramadol Hydrochloride salt. The total weight of the tablets comes to 433.65 grams as per the report of the Forensic Science Laboratory. The recovery from the petitioner falls in the commercial category.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of more than 3 years 10 months.

On instructions from Sh. Sukhbir Singh, ASI, PS Sadar, Sangrur, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab submits that

the petitioner is a previous convict vide judgment dated 29.04.2019 under the NDPS Act, 1985.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
