The grievance of the petitioner in this writ petition is that statutory appeal as has been preferred against the order of resumption dated 16.03.2023 (Annexure P-25) alongwith an application of stay which was subsequently filed before the Appellate Authority i.e. Chief Administrator (GMADA)-respondent No.2 have not been listed.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that order for eviction is likely to be passed on 25.04.2023 which is the date fixed.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Addl. A.G. Punjab, has brought to the notice of the Court that he has received instructions that the application for stay as well as the appeal has been ordered to be listed on 28.04.2023.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends that further if an order of eviction is passed on 25.04.2023, the very purpose of filing of appeal and

the application would automatically be rendered infructuous.

In the given facts and circumstances of the present case, we dispose of the writ petition with an observation that status with regard to the possession shall be maintained till a decision is taken by the appellate authority on the application for stay or the appeal whichever is earlier.
