1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to issue appointment letter and to place the petitioner in seniority list at its proper place, in view of the judgment dated 04.12.2018 (Annexure P-5).

2. Learned State counsel has produced a copy of letter dated 22.09.2023 informing the Court that the petitioner do fall within the selection zone and has been selected at merit No.107-A in waiting of General Category for the post of UDC against Advertisement No.3/2016, Cat. No.02 and her name has been recommended for appointment. A copy of the said letter is taken on record as Mark A.

3. Though, counsel for the petitioner is not present today, this Court deems it appropriate that there is no reason to disbelieve the communication forwarded by Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. AG. Haryana before this Court and in the

light of the same, the claim of the petitioner seems to have been satisfied and probably on that account alone, there is no representation on her behalf.

4. In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant petition, which has been rendered infructuous. Accordingly, disposed of.

5. In case, the petitioner still remains dissatisfied and the appointment letter is not made, in pursuance to this letter dated 22.09.2023, she shall be at liberty to get the petition revive by submitting an application accordingly.
