VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the Punjab State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Open Access) Regulations, 2005 and further for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the petition of the petitioner Company in accordance with the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Learned State Counsel contends that the aforesaid Regulations have seemingly undergone a lot of changes and probably would have been superseded by subsequent Regulations as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is no longer in contact with him.

At this stage, it seems that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner for seeking revival of the present petition, in case his grievance still survives.
