The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the respondents No.4 to 7 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that the whereabouts of Balwinder Kaur, petitioner No.1 are not known, whereas the petitioner No.2 has not shown any threat to the life and liberty. The police has inquired the matter and it has been found that there no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required.

The present petition is accordingly disposed off.
