1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.0319 dated 21.10.2017 under Section 420 IPC, Police Station Julana, District Jind (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

2. Pursuant to order dated 18.5.2022 passed by this Court, report has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jind, relevant extract of which is as under:-

“It is submitted that the complainant has not appeared before the Court to give the statement regarding compromise within stipulated period. The accused have

appeared before the Court on 11.07.2022 but the complainant has not appeared. It appears from the communication with the accused that the complainant is not ready to give the statement before the Court in support of compromise. Therefore, presently the complainant appears to be not agreed with the compromise with the accused. As per statement of IO there is one accused in the present case namely Shamsher Singh and the complainant is Dinesh Kumar. One more FIR bearing No.32 of 2017 under Sections 419/420/465/468/469/471 IPC P.S. Julana is also pending against the accused and he is under trial in the present case. No accused is P.O. in the present case.

3. As per the report, the complainant has not supported the compromise.

4. In view of the above, there is no merit in the petition, which is hereby dismissed.
