Prayer in this petition is for transfer of the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 12(i)(c) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending before the Family Court, Jind to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed a short reply to submit that the respondent has no objection in case the aforesaid petition is transferred to a competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed with the following directions:-

- (i) *The petition filed under Section 12(i)(c) of the Hindu Marriage Act, pending before the Family Court, Jind will be transferred to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Panchkula.*
- (ii) *The District Judge, Panchkula will assign the*

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said petition to the competent Court of jurisdiction.

- (iii) The Family Court at Jind is directed to transfer all the record pertaining to the aforesaid case to District Judge, Panchkula.*
- (iv) The parties are directed to appear before the trial Court at Panchkula within a period of 01 month from today.*
- (v) The Courts concerned, where the cases are pending between the parties, will accommodate them with one date in a calendar month.*
