1. The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.13 dated 14.01.2021 registered under Sections 307, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act (Section 201 of the IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act added and Section 25 of the Arms Act deleted lateron) at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar as well as Rapat No.35 dated 16.01.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of

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compromise dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-3).

2. Vide order dated 27.02.2023 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate on 24.03.2023 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

3. As per report received from the Trial Court, the parties did not comply with the order dated 27.02.2023 passed by this Court vide which they had been directed to get their statements recorded before the Court concerned with respect to the compromise arrived at between them.

4. Learned counsel for the private parties submit that they have no further instructions in the said regard.

5. In the circumstances, no ground is made out to quash the FIR and Rapat in question.
