There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Similar was the position on the previous four occasions.

Petitioners have approached this Court *inter-alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside order dated 02.07.2002, Annexure P-3, whereby their claim for regularization of their services has been declined.

On 07.02.2020, counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners would be satisfied in case their cases for regularization are considered under the policy of 2011. Pursuant thereto, an order dated 18.05.2020, Annexure R-1, has been passed by Director General, Ayush, Haryana, wherein it has been mentioned that petitioners No.1, 2, 4 and 5 are not entitled to regularization in terms of policy dated 29.07.2011. It has been

further mentioned that petitioners No.3 and 6 have already been regularized.

In view of the above position, writ petition qua petitioners No.3 and 6 is rendered infructuous. In so far as petitioners No.1, 2, 4 and 5 are concerned, writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the said petitioners to challenge the order dated 18.05.2020 by filing a fresh writ petition, if so advised.
