1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.2 to re-issue passport to the petitioner after correcting his actual date of birth.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner was issued passport bearing No. R710844 on 28.11.2017 which is valid upto 27.11.2027. Due to inadvertent mistake, the date of birth of the petitioner was mentioned as 01.11.1999 whereas actual date of birth is 21.11.2001. The petitioner has preferred representation to Passport Authorities seeking correction of his date of birth. The petitioner has enclosed relevant documents in support of his contention.

3. Mr. Amit Sharma, Advocate, learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner may be directed to appear before

Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh on 13.07.2023 alongwith all relevant documents and officer concerned would pass an appropriate order within 2 weeks thereafter.

4. In view of statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh on 13.07.2023 at 11:00 A.M alongwith all relevant documents. On doing so, the respondents shall pass an appropriate order within 2 weeks from 13.07.2023.
