On 28.04.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the Order dated 24.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Moga whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in complaint case No.NACT 293 of 2018 titled as Satpal Vs. Lakhvir Singh under Section 138 of the NI Act, 1991 pending in the court of JMIC, Moga.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

Notice of motion for 19.07.2023.

Mr. Ashutosh Pandey, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of responden tno.2 and has filed his power of attorney.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one week from today and subject to his depositing Rs.15,000/- as

costs with Association for Children with Type 1 Diabetes SCO No.24, Sector 23-C, Chandigarh, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

The Counsel for the petitioner states that in deference to the aforesaid order the petitioner has surrendered himself before the Trial Court and has since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is expected that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and not absent himself from the proceedings without sufficient cause.
