AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. On 26.04.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.622 dated 25.10.2018, registered under Sections 323, 307, 302, 506, 34 of IPC and Sections 24-54-59 of Arms at Police Station City Mahendergarh, District Mahendergarh.

Learned Senior counsel contends that the petitioner was declared innocent by the Police during investigation and was kept in column No.2, however, on an application filed under Section 319 CrPC, she has now been summoned. The allegations against her are of having exhorted the main accused, which he submits are false and the petitioner is being implicated only because she is the wife of the main accused. She is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 05.07.2023.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 03.05.2023, she be released on bail, subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.”

2. Learned counsel submits that in pursuance of aforesaid order, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court on 27.04.2023 and has been granted bail.
3. Learned State counsel affirms that aforesaid factum.
4. In view of the above, order dated 26.04.2023 is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) CrPC.
