This petition has been filed under Section 226 of the constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant protection of life and liberty to the petitioner at the hands of private respondents nos.5 to 8, alleging that they have got released the deed in their name by force and are threatening to eliminate the petitioner and in spite of representations dated 13.12.2022 and 28.01.2023 (Annexures P-4 & P-5) no action has been taken by the official respondents.

Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation dated 28.01.2023 (Annexure P-5 alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty to

SHO, Farukhnagar (Gurugram).

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within **six weeks** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
