(1) Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.18 dated 02.02.2023 registered under Sections 306, 120-B, 202 and 201 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala.

(2) On 26.04.2023 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia relies on the issuance of notice and grant of ad interim protection to similarly placed coaccused Harjinder Kaur @ Jinder and Rajdeep Kaur, who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M No.13132 of 2023 - Harjinder Kaur @ Jinder Vs. State of Punjab and CRM-M No.18938 of 2023 – Rajdeep Kaur Vs. State of Punjab.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 16.05.2023.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.13132 of 2023.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a concise status report.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 18 dated 02.02.2023 registered under Sections 306, 120-B, 202 and 201 IPC at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

(3) Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation and that the State no longer requires the petitioner for investigation purposes.

(4) In the light of the afore statement made on behalf of the State as

also for the reason that the orders granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the similarly placed co-accused-Harjinder Kaur @ Jinder and Rajdeep Kaur, who had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-13132-2023-*Harjinder Kaur @ Jinder vs. State of Punjab* and CRM-M-18938-2023-*Rajdeep Kaur vs. State of Punjab*, have already been made absolute, subject to the petitioner’s abiding by the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C the order of this Court dated 26.04.2023, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
