The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in the above-mentioned case.

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the directions of this Court, the FSL report qua the CD has not been presented. The petitioner submits that the trial is hanging fire.

2. State has opposed the present petition on the ground that quantity involved in FIR is commercial in nature.

3. After arguing for sometime counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied if the trial Court be directed to expedite the disposal of case in a time bound manner as petitioner is facing hardship.

4. Given the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2022 as per paragraph 9 of the present petition, the trial Court is directed to conclude trial on or before 31.07.2023 subject to the condition that the petitioner shall not seek any adjournment. In case, the petitioner seeks any adjournment, then this order shall be recalled under Section 362 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. without any further reference to this Court.

5. The present petition stands disposed of with above said observations. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.
