The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 9 to restrain respondent No.10 Truck Operator Union from interfering in the work/business of the petitioner.

The said respondent No.10 had been proceeded against ex parte vide order dated 29.11.2022 and therefore, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had sought time to seek instructions as to whether any grievance still subsists or not especially in the light of the stand taken by the official respondents that whenever any complaint is filed, the required action had been taken by the Authorities. Whenever complaints inter se had been submitted, the same had been resolved by the local police. No replication to controvert the aforesaid stand of official respondents has been filed even though the written statement had been filed way back in May 2019.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that in view of above, the present petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
