1. The petitioner before this Court has herself filed a suit at Kurukshetra with respect to an immovable property located within the territorial jurisdiction of Kurukshetra, in the year 2021. Now, she has filed an application for its transfer from Kurukshetra to the court of competent jurisdiction at Jagraon, District Ludhiana. The plaintiff claims that her other son Gurtej Singh got an FIR registered against the defendants in the suit. The defendants no. 1 to 6 are the other three sons and daughters of the plaintiff. Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the applicant started residing with her son Gurtej Singh in Canada and now she is residing with her daughter at Raikot, District Ludhiana.

2. In the considered view of the Court, in the facts and circumstances of the case, the plaintiff has failed to make out a case for transfer. The plaintiff-petitioner is not required to be present on each and every date of hearing.

- 3. Hence, dismissed.
- 4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
