1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.07.2017 passed in CWP-18525-2015.
2. Short reply dated 23.08.2023 by way of affidavit of Rahul Mittal, HCS, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Hisar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 05.07.2017 has already been complied with and representation filed by the petitioner, in pursuance of the order dated 19.12.2019 passed in COCP-3466-2017, has been decided. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
