Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice and raises no objection for the grant of the prayer as made in the present petition.

Keeping in view the above, application is allowed and on the oral request of learned counsel for the parties, the main case is taken up today for hearing.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to withdraw her claim for the grant of compassionate appointment but with regard to the claim of the petitioner for the grant of ex-gratia amount for which she is entitled for under 2003 Policy, which has not been considered by the respondents, the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents to claim the same by filing appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the said claim in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in case any claim is raised by the petitioner for the grant of ex-gratia amount under 2003 Policy, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim/representation and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit after the said decision, the same will be extended to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
