By way of the instant revision petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the issuance of a direction to learned Rent Controller, Patiala to decide the Rent Petition titled as '*Manmeet Singh vs. Amarjit Singh @ Bittu and others*' (CIS No.RP/32/2020, CNR No.PBPT020013742020), in a time bound manner.
