1. In the present petition, the petitioner is claiming eligibility to compete for the post of Junior Engineer.

2. By an interim order, the petitioner was allowed to appear in the selection process provisionally. In order to find out, whether the prayer raised in the present petition survives or the same has been rendered academic, the provisional result of the petitioner was called for.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner-Gulshan Kumar has secured 158 marks including the marks given for interview whereas, the last candidate selected in the General Category has secured 178 marks, which are much more than the marks secured by the petitioner-Gulshan Kumar.

4. Keeping in view the above, as the petitioner has not been able to secure marks equivalent to the marks secured by the last selected candidate in the General Category, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
