The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 and 2 to release the electricity connection to the petitioner, which is not being released on account of recovery due against the premises in question.

Mr. Gurnoor Singh Sethi, Advocate appears and files power of attorney on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2. He further submits on instructions from Mr. Chunish Jain, Asstt. Executive Engineer, PSPCL, the grievance of the petitioner already stands redressed and the electricity connection has already been released in the premises in question, which was energized on 06.08.2022 and as such, there is no subsisting grievance of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, however, pleads ignorance about the same.

Be that as it may, in view of the specific statement made by the counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 at Bar today and the copy of certificate produced before this Court, the present petition is hereby disposed as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case, the aforesaid statement is found to be incorrect.
