1. This revision petition is filed seeking directions to District Judge, Chandigarh to decide the petition in a time bound manner.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the Court concerned with a prayer for expeditious disposal of the application under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
3. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
4. There is no doubt that in case the petitioner approaches the Executing Court with the prayer, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
5. Since the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
