1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact the petitioner had married the daughter of respondents No. 4 and 5 against their wishes on 08.06.2022. Thereafter, the private respondents started threatening the petitioner and other family members. He further contends that the respondents No. 4 to 7 alongwith certain unknown persons visited the house of petitioner at Mohali and had assaulted and abused him. He further contends that he had approached the local police but no action was taken on his representation.

3. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the DSP, City II, District SAS Nagar, has been filed on behalf of the official respondents. Learned

State counsel submits that the grievances of the petitioner including the representation (Annexure P-2) have been looked into and it has been found that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents. Still further, even Ameesha wife of the petitioner has joined the respondents No. 4 to 7 and there is no reason to extend the threats to the present petitioner. He has further assured the Court that in case any representation is received from the petitioner with regard to the threat to his life and liberty, appropriate action shall be taken on the same, in accordance with law.

4. In view of submissions made by the learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
