1. The petitioner prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 28.02.2023, whereby the official junior to the petitioner has been handed over the charge of the School while ignoring the petitioner's claim.

2. On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from Sh. Anil Kumar, DO, Secondary, District Education Officer, Ludhiana, has submitted that there are serious allegations against the petitioner with regard to embezzlement and mis-utilization of funds in the mid day meal scheme and a charge-sheet has already been issued to him. The charge has been handed over only for a temporary period.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for is made out.

4. Dismissed.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
