Present application has been filed for disposing of the main case in view of the compromise dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure A-1) executed between the parties.

Learned counsel for non-applicants/petitioners has affirmed the submissions made by learned counsel for applicant/respondent No.4 that both the sides have amicably resolved the issue.

Learned State counsel also affirms the same.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the material on record, the prayer made in the application is allowed.

Present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.3, vide which petition filed by respondent No.4 under the provisions of Punjab Religious Premises & Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1997 for eviction of the petitioner from the demised premises, has been allowed. Further prayer has been made for staying the operation of impugned order dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.3.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Both the parties would be bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise dated 14.02.2023 arrived at between the parties.
