Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that instead of taking an action against the guilty persons, the police had registered the FIR No. 96 dated 05.04.2023 under Section 61(1)(a) of Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar, (Annexure P-2) against the petitioner regarding which representation Annexure P-3 was moved bearing No. CMOFF/N/2023/043352 but no action has been taken till date.

Heard.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vishal Malik, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State and files the status report received from SHO, Police Station, Bass, dated 16.05.2023. He submits that in fact the police is acting on the representation but it is the petitioner who is not cooperating to get his medical examination conducted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that as and when any notice will be received by the petitioner, the petitioner will cooperate in the enquiry.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation, Annexure P-3, expeditiously, in accordance with law, and the decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner as well.
