1. The petitioners herein pray for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order passed on 17.04.2023, whereby, their empanelment has been discontinued on account of alleged misconduct. In fact, the petitioners were empanelled in the *Aam Aadmi* Clinics opened by the State of Punjab. Their employment was neither on temporary nor on permanent basis.

2. Upon realizing this fact, the learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the impugned order is stigmatic and hence it could not be passed without inquiry.

3. On instructions from Dr. Akshay Bhargava, Department of health, Punjab, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab submits that he has no objection if the aforesaid order is treated as a simplicitor order of not continuing the petitioners empanelment.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and discussion, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
