On 27.04.2023, learned State counsel sought time to have instructions with regard to pendency of representations i.e. Annexure P-3 and P-4, submitted by the petitioner.

In reference thereof, learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Raj Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, PBI (Economic Offence & Cyber Crime) Ludhiana, which is taken on record.
