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**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

1. This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed for setting aside the order dated 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 dismissing the application of the petitioner for recalling of Kalandra issued under Sections 145 and 146 Cr.P.C.

2. The property in question is a Guga Madi. The civil dispute relating to property in question is pending before the Apex Court and there is an interim order for maintaining *status quo*.

3. The grievance of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that as consequence of kalandra private respondents are being benefited with offerings of the Guga Madi.

4. Learned counsel for respondents No. 7 to 11 submits that in view of the status quo order dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2016 passed by Apex Court in SLP(c) No.28275 of 2016, kalandra has lost its significance and it is only to maintain law and order.

5. In view of the interim order passed by the Supreme Court, learned counsel for the petitioners is not pressing the present petition at this stage and seeks liberty to avail remedies for redressal of surviving grievance if any.

6. The petition is dismissed as not pressed of with liberty as prayed for.

7. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
