1. I have heard the applicant, who appears in person and Mr. Sunil Chadha, learned Senior counsel.
2. The sole ground raised by the applicant is that while deciding the Regular Second Appeal, the Bench took note of the order dated 10.08.2022 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Revenue Punjab, whereas the said order was under review before the Financial Commissioner. It is the case of the applicant that the High Court should have waited for the decision on the Review Application pending before the Financial Commissioner.
3. Learned Senior Counsel has opposed the prayer made by the applicant stating that re-appreciation of the matter on the merits of the case is not permissible. It has also been submitted that it is the finding of the Civil Court which would be binding on the revenue Court and not that this Court would be bound by the findings given by the revenue Courts.
4. I have considered the matter.
5. I do not find any error on the face of the record warranting exercise of revisional jurisdiction. It is settled law that no review on merits is permissible in law. Still further, there was no occasion for this Court to wait for the decision of the Revenue Courts.
6. In view of the above, the present review application does not call for any interference by this Court.

The review application is accordingly dismissed. All pending applications stand disposed of.
