Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate the complaint dated 01.01.2023 lodged with respondent No.3 in a fair and impartial manner. With further prayer to protect life and liberty of petitioner No.1 and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioner that respondents No.4 and 5 are habitual offenders. She submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2023 under Sections 307, 34 of IPC and Section 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Farakpur and there is no fair and impartial investigation being conducted. However, learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to the status report filed today and he has argued that petitioner No.2-Rajan Verma has got registered one FIR No.218 dated 05.08.2019, under Sections 387, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Farakpur against Ishu @ Ishant Sharma and also registered a case bearing FIR No.116 dated

27.02.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 427, 452, 506 of IPC, at Police Station Farakpur against Ishant Sharma @ Ishu, Deepu Sharma, Sachin and others. He submits that in FIR No.218 dated 05.08.2019, Ishant Sharma @ Ishu has been acquitted by the trial Court whereas FIR No.116 dated 27.02.2020 is under trial. He submits that FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2023 registered by the petitioner against the respondent has been duly investigated and the challan has already been presented before the Court.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, it is apparent that the investigation in FIR No.01 dated 01.01.2023 is already complete and the challan has been presented. Hence, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to raise all their grievances before the trial Court as per law.
