The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. apprehending arrest of the petitioner in case FIR No.282 dated 15.12.2022 under Sections 324, 323, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC (offence under section 326, 458 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Status report dated 12.07.2023 has been filed in Court, which is taken on record. A copy thereof furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that investigation in this case has been completed and the petitioner is found to be innocent and as such, petitioner is not required by the police in the FIR noticed above.
