Learned counsel for the petitioner states that mentioning of note at the bottom of the index at 1st page is wrong on his part and he requested to delete the same and also requested the same to be read as deleted by the Registry as well.

On the request of the petitioner, prayer is accepted.

Registry is directed to make necessary corrections and correct page of index be supplied to the Registry within three days from today.

The very fact is also evident from the memo of parties, wherein, respondent No.4 is shown to be wife of Naresh Kumar, who is father of petitioner No.1 and therefore, it is evident that in fact, respondent No.4- Sunita is mother of petitioner No.1.

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate protection to the petitioners

and also directing the respondent No.4 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.1 to 3 to look into the representation dated 20.04.2023 (Annexure P-3), within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks.

The petition is disposed of with the above direction.
